





2005 Perpetual Trophy Recipients

Robert Collins Memorial Trophy

In memory of Bob Collins of the Detroit Region who was fatally injured racing his MG-TC in Canada in 1950. The Detroit Region had the unique trophy made from a design by George Gaston, former RE. It is a perpetual trophy awarded to the outstanding racing competitor for the past season. For many years the award was given to the driver of a car under 1600 cc's, but more recently the award has been made to the competitor with the most National racing points in E, F, G, H Production; GT3, GT4, GT5; Sports 2000; Spec Racer Ford; and C, D Sports Racing. **This year's honoree is Paul Young.**

Karl Pel Memorial Trophy

Mary and Jerry Shiloff were the deserving winners of this trophy. The Detroit Region established this memorial trophy to honor one of its most dedicated members, Karl Pel, who passed away on November 8, 1974. Karl will be remembered best for the time and energy he devoted to the Club. He was not just in attendance at most of the races, rallies and meetings, but he was there helping, whenever needed. He seemed to have a knack of being in the right place at the right time-hot coffee for cold registrars, food for the hungry tech inspectors and his car was a ready source of most anything a worker could possibly need. However, Karl had a way of doing all these things for people without being obvious about it. He shied away from the limelight and stayed in the background whenever he could. This trophy is presented each year to the worker (s) who has devoted an exceptional amount of time and effort toward promoting our sport and the Detroit Region.

Tom Hallock Memorial Trophy

Tom Hallock was a competitor, a worker, a political force, and most important, a friend to many in the Detroit Region. Tom took extra time with the "new kids." He seemed to shine with new members: a word of encouragement, friendly advice, gentle guidance. Those who worked or competed with him will never forget his warm smile.

The Region established this trophy to recognize the new member who gives the most of themselves to the Region and the SCCA. Any member who has not completed their second year of Detroit Region membership by December 31 of the award year is eligible. **Congratulations to both Deric Frisch and Mike Rodriguez as the 2005 recipients.**

Ira Garfunkel Memorial Trophy

Keith Roberts II was the worthy receiver of this year's Ira Garfunkel Memorial Trophy. This trophy was established in 1955 to honor one of Detroit Region's serious competitors. Ira Garfunkel was competing in a hillclimb at Haven Hill at the time of his death. This trophy is presented in his memory to a Region member who displays outstanding sportsmanship and excellence.

The Robert Siegmund (RE's) Award

Awarded by the Regional Executive for outstanding contributions toward the advancement of the Detroit Region.

This award is named in honor of Robert Siegmund, a long time member and past RE of the Detroit Region who passed away in 2001. Bob was always careful with the financial side of the operation of the Region and recognized the need to both Bond and Insure the Region's assets. He was always available for consultation and advice concerning all aspects of the Region. **This years award went to Jody Jacobs, posthumously.**
