#### a. Race (Jerry Shiloff)

- ii. GL Divisional Championship 2-day event will be June 25 and 26, at I96 Speedway. The SCCA Sanction has been completed.

#### **d. Solo** (Matt Wolfe)

- i. The After FSAE meeting was held at MIS on May 15.
- ii. Summer Heat Solo will be held at Schoolcraft on June 18. The entry cap is 120.
- iii. Test N Tune will be on July 2-4 and After the Fireworks on July 8-10 at Oscoda.

#### e. Asst. RE (Mike Nienhius)

1. The Membership meeting was held on April 27 at the Box Bar and Grill, Plymouth, with 35 people in attendance. Assistant RE, Mike Nienhuis presented past and future club activities with Aaron Usher presenting the finances.

- iv. There were two oil dumps and one impact (after a brake failure) during the Autocross on Friday. No incidents on Saturday but weather provided snow, sleet and wind resulting in a late start.
- v. European teams dominated the events, taking the top three places, but Oregon State, Michigan State and U of Wisconsin took the next three.

- vii. There was only one ambulance present, so the event would have had to be delayed if it had to transport someone away from the site. This is an SAE responsibility.

#### Pat's Notes...

#### Live Timing

- 1. We were able to successfully implement LT&S www.drscca.org/livetiming/
- 2. We purchased a Pay as you go Wireless Hotspot \$50 (one time cost). The cost of the data is \$25 for 1.5 GB for 30 days (enough for 1-2 events), or \$50 for 10gb (enough for 8-10) events, but again it only lasts 30 days. We will need to determine how to properly bill this to the events.
- 3. Some work will need to be done with output format to include DRSCCA website and perhaps our
- 4. A new landing page should be generated at DRSCCA.org for livetiming for better ease of use.
- 5. LT&S was used during FSAE.

#### FunMover

- 1. The new layout of the FM represents a portable Timing Tower. It has eliminated the issue with people standing in front of the FM during events.
- 2. We need to replace a failed laptop. The Dell laptop has serious hardware issues and has become unreliable. A budget will be submitted in June or online for a replacement. ~\$300.00
- 3. The electric step is still non-functional. Suspect failed electronic module \$90.00
- 4. FM transmitter was successfully implemented at FSAE and After FSAE Solo. Good sound quality and range.

#### **FSAE**

- 1. Challenging, but very successful week! Extreme cold, snow and sleet, long days
- 2. No major incidents on or off the course.
- 3. One moderate (Moderate?) issue with the damage to the easy up awnings. Awnings blew away during the early morning (4:40 am) Saturday. One frame damaged beyond reasonable repair. One frame can be repaired with parts from damaged unit. Replacement frame available for \$399 from manufacturer. Less expensive than new unit @ \$539.
- 4. Team struggled with clean up on Saturday. Cold weather and fatigue played as major factors in getting things packed properly
  - a. FM was used by FSAE for T&S during the event. Typically the FM is not used on Saturday by SCCA or FSAE for this event. Since national office trailer was not available, FM was put into service for T&S. This put a strain on the team as they prepared for the Solo event the next day.

5. Quantity of Skilled Volunteers - Solo & F&C- We need to work on this for next year.
