

Minutes of Board of Directors Meeting Wed. June 13, 2018
On the Border, Northville, MI

Meeting called to order at 7:00pm.

1. Current and Online Business

- a. May 2018 minutes were approved online.
- **b.** Travel reimbursement policies update in progress.
- **c. Web Master** no interest so far. Need a more active search. A budget will be presented at the next meeting. Suggest \$100/month max.
- **d.** Capital Equipment Report a corrected report was presented (Appendix 1).
- e. Budget Subcommittee no activity. Need budget forms to be fixed. A new committee will be assigned, to include someone from Autocross, and objectives to be defined. Volunteers John Kytasty and Keith Armitage.
- **f. 2018 Contract submissions** copies of site contracts for race and autocross should be forwarded to Frank P.
- **g.** Thayer Automotive Sponsorship Meeting, June 8, 2018. They were asked for an increase. We should hear within a week.

2. Reports (including new/updated 2018 Event Budgets and follow up)

a. Race

- i. **Spring Sprints –** GingerMan, May 19-20. There were 100 entries, 10 more than last year. It rained. There were 10 no shows.
- ii. **Northern Conference Majors** at GingerMan, July 7 & 8. Entries are down, probably due to Runoffs being at Sonoma, CA. Breakeven is 120 cars. Co-sponsored with South Bend Region.
- iii. **Track night**, GingerMan, GLDiv, went well but there were some issues with waivers not being signed.

b. Rallycross

- i. Thistle Hill (#5) despite some rain, it was dusty. Compliments on course design. There were 50 entries (max.) but some left early allowing a couple of standbys to run in the afternoon. Generated a surplus.
- ii. Oakshade (#6) June 24. Already oversubscribed.
- iii. Great Lakes Champ. Series (#7 & 8), July 28 &29. I-96 Speedway. The budget was presented. (Appendix 2). Motion to approve, Scott Harvey,



2nd, John Kytasty. Discussion: worker points changed to 50 since this is a 2-day event. Nothing budgeted for trophies since these will be the usual photographs. Unanimously approved with change.

c. Autocross

- i. Completed Events AutoX School, April 13 & 14, Final budget (Appendix 3). Season Opener, April 15, final budget (Appendix 4).
- ii. Drive into Spring May 5. 171 entries.
- **iii. Memorial Day** May 28 -MIS, used parking lot. MIS promised infield in October. 168 entries with 4 runs each. Worker points have been submitted.
- iv. Summer Heat June 9, Schoolcraft.167 entries, 154 with times. Had some rain.
- v. Roush cone rental June 8, (Appendix 5). Roush paid \$200 for cone rental for their autocross the day before the Summer Heat event. We also designed the course and so should have had insurance coverage. Use of SCCA equipment and services by a non SCCA customer must be preapproved by the BOD.
- vi. Oscoda TNT June 30 July 2. Not needing Funmover, clarify with chairman.
- vii. After the Fireworks, July 13, 14. Oscoda. Joint with SVR, no Funmover.
- **viii. Oscoda Pro Solo,** August 3 5. Need Funmover. Have signed contract. Will put preliminary budget online.
- ix. Before Nationals, August 17 19.

d. Rally

- Moonlight Monte July 21 Moonlight Monte is in progress. Sanction request submitted and approved, and we have insurance certificate. Awaiting flyer with details from chairman/rallymaster Dennis Wiedbusch to set up MotorsportReg registration page for the rally.
- **ii.** Pavement Ends Due to two, conflicts (GLD divisional RX, Nathan Usher & Marianna Langosch's wedding) the Pavement Ends rally has been rescheduled from November 17 to November 10 instead. SCCA, DR and GLD calendars have been updated accordingly.

e. Asst. RE

i. Banquet – next February. Need feedback on location. Suggestions to Cindy W. who will choose best location.

f. RE

- i. Online votes need more participation. Get notification by email; go to the Forum you wish to be updated on, at the bottom of the page, tick "Subscribe Forum".
- **ii. Online discussion** not recorded in minutes. However, budgets do get mentioned in "Online Business, and attached as appendices.

g. Treasurer

- i. Cash We have approx. \$157k in the bank.
- ii. Tax return it will be done soon.



iii. PO Box has been reopened. There are two keys; BThorpe and DAssenmacher have them. (Informed delivery is not available for our PO Box.) DA will look into automatic renewal.

h. Membership report

- i. We have 1447 members, a decrease of 4; 30 new, 34 lost.
- ii. Service awards 10 were sent out.
- iii. Foreign check charge a Canadian member paid with worker points and a small check. The SCCA bank charged \$30 to process the foreign check. Jen Glass discussed this issue with various SCCA personnel.

i. Equipment

- i. Conquistador needs new tire.
- **ii. DGP** strained use of fire extinguisher and flags. If run next year we will need to buy more. Flag sets cost \$300.
- **iii. Fire extinguishers** we have four low pressure extinguishers, which leave a non-removable crust no one wants them.
- j. Open Exhaust next issue will be Summer 2018.
- k. Street Survival® Sanction request has been submitted. MSReg being done.
- I. Website/Social media Message forum software has successfully been upgraded from 3.0.14 to 3.2.2, the most current available version. Going forward, John Fishbeck will be keeping the software upgraded to most current versions as they become available.

Appendix 5 – Roush cone rental agreement

Detroit Region SCCA Equipment Lease Agreement

This Equipment Lease ("Lease") is made effective as of 7 June, 2018 by and between Detroit Region, SCCA ("Lessor") and Jack Roush Jr. ("Lessee"). The agreement of the parties is as

1. Equipment subject to Lease: Lessor shall lease the following Equipment ("Equipment"):
