

Minutes of Board of Directors Meeting Wed. October 10, 2018
On the Border, Novi, MI

### Attendees:

Meeting called to order at 7:00pm.

#### 1. Current and Online Business

- a. September 2018 minutes were not approved online, with 7 yes votes but only 6 yes comments! Motion to approve Cindy Wisner, 2<sup>nd</sup> Keith Armitage, unanimously approved.
- **b. BOD Travel reimbursement** policies update in progress.
- c. Election Update the provisional ballot was circulated for comment. Some Canadian members had their ballots returned because they requested "Return Receipt". This cannot be accommodated with a PO Box address. A note will be added to the ballot accordingly.
- d. Budget and Capital Spending Subcommittee Keith Armitage presented new forms with common items simplified. A version control is needed. "Temporary Memberships" should be changed to "Weekend Memberships". Delete "Telephone". Add "MSReg Fees". Keith will update the forms. The plan is to use these forms in 2019. (Appendices 1 and 2).

### 2. Reports (including new/updated 2018 Event Budgets and follow up)

### a. Race

- i. Majors had a surplus of \$516. Next year this event will be in May.
- ii. Time Trials see RE report.
- iii. Regional will be the 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend of July.

### b. Rallycross

- i. #8 at I96 Speedway was rained out and postponed until 20th October.
- ii. Great Lakes Divisional, #9 and 10, will be held at Oakshade on November 3 and 4. GLD did not fund trophies even though they have a trophy fund! We did not have trophy costs in the budget. Frank Putman will discuss with GLD. Jon Trudeau will get quotes for trophies. Cincinnati and Ohio Valley Regions jointly host the event.
- iii. Season Ender, #11, will be at Thistle Hill on December 1st.



iv. **Jon Trudeau, Rallycross Director,** announced he will step down at the end of the year and will be looking for a replacement. However, he will work on the budget for the January event.

#### c. Autocross

- i. Fall into Autumn, Schoolcraft, September 30. This charitable event went well, finished early and allowed 3 fun runs. A provisional final budget is attached. Later, John Kytasty motioned that the donation should be rounded up to \$2,500; Pat Barber seconded, unanimously approved. A cheque will be sent to the American Cancer Society. (Appendix 3.)
- ii. Season Ender, MIS October 13. Will use infield road course. There are 107 entries so far. Ken W. will test the wireless timing system on Friday but will use wired system for event until bugs are worked out.

### d. Rally

- i. POR, September 8 & 9. The final budget showed a loss of \$125 due to extra fuel costs. (Appendix 4).
- ii. Clare Color Tour Sept 29, 200 miles with 15 controls.
- iii. Pavement Ends, November 10 all approved. Need control workers/

#### e. Asst. RE

i. Banquet – first weekend in February 2019. Appendix 5 lists five potential venues. There was discussion on whether additional activities, such as the GM Heritage center provides, would attract more members. Consensus was that there would not be enough time for this. In addition, the Heritage Center would be too expensive. The membership was surveyed about meal preferences, and a buffet is preferred.

#### f. RE

- i. Jumbo Region Conference call. Gingerman 15 June, Time trials Tour SVR and DR. Discussing MIS with Western Region.
- ii. PDX, Performance Driving Experience name is "owned" by another company so SCCA will no longer use "PDX".
- iii. 2019 is the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of DRSCCA. Discussion of activity, item for sale such as shirts, coins, Pop-up tents, although price is high (Appendix 6).
- iv. Runoffs in Sonoma. There are 15 racers going to the runoffs in California. Frank Putman motioned for each to receive a "Tow Fund" of \$250, seconded by Pat Barber. Discussion involved the extra cost to participate due to the travel distance; setting a precedent; what about VIR in 2019?; this was provided many years ago; other Regions provide this; should this be mileage based? The motion was carried by 12 votes for, and 1 against.

### g. Treasurer

i. Cash - We have approx. \$182k in the bank.

### h. Membership report

i. We have 1347 members, a net loss of 51 members. We gained 16 new members since last meeting, which means 67 members either did not



renew their membership or transferred to another region. 34 of those were Grand Prix volunteers who were given a free membership and decided not to renew since they have no other involvement with the Region. SCCA replaced the Volunteer Racing Incentive Program with the Membership Retention program so this will not be an issue in future.

ii. Service awards – 6 were sent out at the beginning of October.

### i. Equipment

- i. Empire Hillclimb Sept 15. Timing equipment worked well.
- **ii. Fire Extinguishers**, every region certifies these annually. KW will get quotes for certification. Have used Detroit Fire Extinguisher Co. before but not tied to them.
- iii. Conquistador needs new tires. Will get Nokians from Team Harco for \$1,000 plus \$100 for mounting. Cheaper than Michelins. Took it to Ford dealer, who said brakes are shot. Pads and rotors will cost \$1,300.
- iv. TSD Clocks. LSPR lost 10 timewise clocks and want to rent some from us. Mary is getting the signed rental agreement. In future, we will charge \$200 for clock rental, instead of getting 9V batteries.
- v. The Gator is in good shape.
- vi. Autocross at MIS this weekend will use the same setup as at Empire.
- vii. Bar Code Reader for Autocross was tested OK.
- j. Open Exhaust was published last weekend.
- k. Street Survival on September 22 coincided with Homecoming so there were 5 no shows! Vehicle staging changes reduced set up time. Only had 15 volunteers, could have used more. We would like to put on a Regional Street Survival. Another group, B.R.A.K.E.S., (Be Responsible And Keep Everyone Safe), put on an event on Belle Isle on Sept. 29-30. Kia provided 30 cars. They also had the parents drive to show them what bad habits are passed on to their teenagers.
- Website/Social media Event results for Autocross and Rallycross for 2018 are missing. John Li will investigate.

### m. Special Events

- i. FSAE, final budget will be available from Mike McClintock at the next meeting.
- **ii. Detroit GP** Chief of Emergency Services, Richard "Blackie" Meyers retirement party was held on September 25, attended by Frank Putman and Jerry Shiloff and many volunteers.
- **iii. Empire Hillclimb** is not our event but we were asked to run it again. We asked for \$500 towards the use of equipment. Autoweek, the print and digital publication, provided welcome advertising.
- **n. Social events.** This year is the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Detroit Region. A special event, yet to be determined, will be held. Ideas please.
- o. Calendar Review discussed events planned over the next few months.

#### 3. New Business

**a. Treasurer**, Jen Glass asked us to think about the running of our club from the non-profit point of view. What to do with spare cash etc.


