Midsummer IV Rally Results

As with prior years Midsummer Rallies, we intended to set up an event that was difficult enough that everyone would feel challenged, easy enough that no one would get lost, clean enough that competitors would not find mistakes, and with some innovations that would be of interest to competitors and other organizers. From the comments at the finish, most people thought the objectives were achieved.

The most troublesome leg for competitors was the final one where competitors were asked to look for cemeteries (with a confirming sign), and those that spent too much time looking were late to the control less than a half mile later. We originally had the control further down the road, but were concerned about speeding to make up time. Only two cars had under 5 hundredths error.

Those who filled out the new CER forms provided by Jim Mickle gave the event mostly positive reviews. Most competitors liked the level of difficulty and the timing traps that typical "straightforward" rallies lack. Speeds were rated too slow by about half the competitors, and just right by the rest. Several mentioned they would prefer less DIYC controls. A lack of available control workers on a summer weekend (two late cancellations) led to this being the only way to have 12 scoreable controls. The results also showed very little difference in scores at DIYC's versus open controls.

Despite the fact that we avoided the use of any regular competitors as workers, which caused a great amount of extra work for us, we had a disappointing entry. Let us know what you think will be successful in bringing out more entrants, and what you like in an event. The time and effort involved in setting up a rally like this for a turnout of less than 20 cars is hard to justify.
