2022 FINANCIAL GOALS

- Find Financial Director to support the Treasurer
- Simplify the chart of accounts to increase the efficiency of bookkeeping and make reporting easier (800 total accounts, 200 active in 2021 – goal is 50)
- Launch use of projects in Quickbooks to ease tracking of income/expense by event, Director, or Specialty Chief versus submitted budget
- Begin forecasting fiscal year surplus or loss to proactively manage the Region's finances
- Seek out better returns for bank accounts

FORMULA SAE

- In 1981, **6 teams / 40 students** competed (@ Univ of TX-Austin)
 - In 2021 the event was held in July @ MIS with dynamic events only
 - **120 Teams** are registered for the 2022 Michigan competition
- **Annual competitions now take place in the United States, Canada and internationally






FORMULA SAE

Skid Pad Event

- 2 circles of 50' diameter in a figure-8 pattern
- 2 drivers per car / 2 runs per driver
- Each run consists of 2-right and 2-left laps






FORMULA SAE

Autocross Event

- Course Length = approx ½ mile
- 2 drivers per car / 2 laps per driver
- Typically 3-4 cars on the track concurrently
- No passing in this "solo" event
- Avg Speeds = 35 to 40 MPH





FORMULA SAE

Endurance & Fuel Economy Event

- Total run = 2 x 8-10 laps
- 2 drivers per car / Driver change midway
- Typically 7-8 cars on the track concurrently
- Passing within designated passing zones
- Avg speed = 35 MPH
- Approx top speed = 65 MPH





FORMULA SAE



On-Track Corner Workers

- *Team on each corner:*
 - Corner Captain
 - Radio Communicator
 - Yellow / Red Flagger
 - Cone (and Gate) Counters
 - Cone Chasers
 - Blue Flaggers
 - Passing Zone Signal Marshals


